"Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?" Isaiah 6:8 NIV

...was a question God asked the prophet Isaiah, when He needed to deliver a complicated and urgent message to the nation of Israel. If the prophet accepted this challenge, he would risk everything, maybe even his own life. In the same way, the first marathon runner, carrying an urgent message, used the last ounce of his strength to deliver it and it cost him his life. Being messengers of an urgent message can be costly.

It was Jesus who won the battle for us by dying on the cross and being resurrected. Today, He calls us "children." We are His family and we can therefore live with the hope that cannot be taken away. Isn't that amazing? The message of hope is the best message we can deliver to our nation. It is a message that changes young people, families, leaders, countries... We are also facing the challenge to become messengers of hope today.

The theme of 2023 was "Being Messengers." Not just being messengers, but also calling and equipping other young people to do the same.

The entire conference for youth leaders (KPM) was devoted to the theme: Messenger of hope. We prepared SHARE- a study and training material for small groups, which discusses the topic - MESSENGER on a daily basis. We had the opportunity to be messengers among students at local schools (EXIT), in sports (EDGE), and in the online world (POINT.online). For a period of ten months, we were leading and equipping a group of youth leaders (ŠPM) to live the life of a messenger of hope in a practical way. We had the honor to work closely with leaders of local churches in four regions of Slovakia and also take care of a small group of university students in Bratislava. During summer camps (KECY), we were able to witness how the message of hope can transform the lives of young people. Thanks to the media, we had the chance to share stories of changed lives through social networks. (C-team).
